Directions

From Wilmington: Take I-40 west for approximately 25 miles to Exit number 398 (Hwy 53) Turn left onto Hwy 53 and drive approximately 4 miles into downtown Burgaw where Hwy 53 becomes E. Bridger Street. Remain on Bridger for four blocks and take a left on Dudley and go two blocks. Park on railroad ROW Race start is on Walker Street 2 blocks east.

From Jacksonville: Follow Hwy 53 for approximately 31 miles. Enter downtown Burgaw where Hwy 53 becomes E. Bridger Street. Remain on Bridger for 4 blocks and take a left on

Dudley and go two blocks. Park in railroad ROW is on the right. Race start is on Walker Street 2 blocks east.

RACE COURSE

5K Run/Walk: The course is flat and fast through historic Burgaw, the county seat of Pender County. The course will have a minimum number of turns throughout the course. The finish line will be located approximately 0.2 miles from the start.

BAG PICK UP/CHECK IN AND RACE DAY REGISTRATION

Pre-race bag pick up at Fitness Fusion, 901 S Walker St, Burgaw.

Race day registration **and** all pre-registered bag pick up/check in begin on race day at 6:20 AM in front of the Burgaw Presbyterian Church corner of Walker and Fremont Streets.

There will be no registration after 7:10 AM.

All entries are non-refundable.

AMENITIES

Professional chip timing will be provided by EHM timing services. The clock will be stopped after one hour and awards given shortly thereafter at the finish line. Water and fresh blueberries and other recovery fruits will be provided at the finish line. Port-a-Johns are located at the courthouse square. A water stop will be provided at the two mile mark and mile markers and time splits available along course.

Male and Female (2 divisions)
