Race Starts and ends at the intersection of Walker and Fremont Streets, in front of Burgaw Presbyterian. Race will start at 7:30 am **sharp**. Parking is available at the Piggly Wiggly and across the street in the railroad right-of-way, 0.2 miles west off of Highway 53.

Directions

From Wilmington: Take 1-40 West for approximately 25 miles to Exit 398 (Hwy 53). Turn left onto Highway 53 and drive approximately 4 miles into downtown Burgaw where Hwy 53 becomes E. Bridger St. Remain on Bridger for four blocks and take a left on Dudley St., going two more blocks. Piggly Wiggly is on the right. Race start is on Walker St. two blocks east.

From Jacksonville: Follow Highway 53 for approximately 31 miles. Enter downtown Burgaw where Hwy 53 becomes E. Bridger St. Remain on Bridger for four blocks and take a left on Dudley St., going two more blocks. Piggly Wiggly is on the right. Race start is on Walker St. 2 blocks east.

Race Course

5K Run/Walk: The course is flat and fast through historic Burgaw, the county seat of Pender County. The finish line will be located approximately 0.2 miles from the start.

BAG PICK UP/CHECK IN & RACE DAY REGISTRATION

There will be no pre-race bag pick-up this year. Race day registration **and** all pre-registered bag pick up/check in begins on race day at 6:30 AM at the Presbyterian Church (starting line) on the corner of Fremont St. and Walker St. **There will be no registration after 7:20 AM.**

Amenities

Professional chip timing will be provided. The clock will be stopped after one hour and awards given shortly thereafter at the finish line. Water, fresh blueberries, and other recovery fruits will be provided at the finish line. Port-a-Johns are located at the courthouse square. A water stop will be provided at the two mile mark, and mile markers and time splits will be available along the course.
