**WHEN:** Sat., June 17, 2017 - Check-in opens at 7:00a.m. All Rides start at 8:30a.m.

**WHERE:** Burgaw Middle School, 500 South Wright Street, Burgaw NC (adjacent to South Dickerson Street). All routes start and end at the School with free parking, restrooms, and complimentary snacks. **Lunch provided free to all registered riders and registered volunteers by TWO FOOD TRUCKS:** PT's (burgers & bbq) and The Little Chef (two tacos, with two types).



**PRE-REGISTRATION:** **Online** at [www.capefearcyclists.org](http://www.capefearcyclists.org) until 10:00p.m. June 11. Pre-registration cost: \$35.00 for adults and \$15.00 for 13 years and younger. **2016 Tour de Blueberry sport shirts provided with pre-registration by June 1st.** Shirts must be picked up on the day of the event.

**MAPS:** Provided on ride day and online at [www.capefearcyclists.org](http://www.capefearcyclists.org). The courses will be well marked.

**DAY OF EVENT REGISTRATION:** 7:00a.m. to 8:00a.m., June 17 at the School. Day of event registration is **\$40.00** for adults and \$15.00 for 13 years and younger. **Check or cash only** (no credit cards). Tour de Blueberry shirts will be available for \$10.00 while supplies last.

**REQUIREMENTS:** **Helmets are required.** All riders must sign a waiver. Riders under 18 must be accompanied on ride by parent. All riders must ensure their bike is in good mechanical condition. Riders should carry water, tube and tools to repair a flat. All riders must obey the rules of the road and CFC.
