Rules & Guidelines

- All non-profits must make application to the association describing what they will be promoting, doing, and/or selling at the festival. Respectively the applicant/organization can give away information pertaining to such organization. The association reserves the right to refuse any non-profit application.
- If a non-profit's primary function at the festival is to sell food, they **MUST** also submit a food vendor application and if accepted, the food vendor fee will be applied and the non-profit must comply with all rules and regulations as other food vendors. **The food vendor fee is \$350.** There are no exceptions to this rule and if a non-profit is not in compliance on festival day, they will be asked to leave and the application fee will not be refunded.
- Non-profit organizations can request to be included in the BLUEBERRY BAKED GOODS category where "homemade" pre-packaged blueberry food items are sold, but they must contact the office for more information. Space is very limited in this category. If included in this category, only blueberry food items can be sold from your booth therefore if you have other items you wish to sell you must also request a space with other non-profit organizations or submit an Arts & Craft application as explained below.
- If a non-profit is selling arts and crafts of any kind, an Arts & Craft vendor fee will be assessed based on a 10' x 10' space. **The Arts & Craft vendor fee is \$100.00.**
- If a non-profit's intent is only to provide information concerning their organization/services and give away **NON-FOOD** items, they will be assessed as a non-profit application fee. The non-profit application fee for a 10' x 10' space is **\$50.00**
- All non-profits will be assigned a space by the appropriate committee. The decision of the committee is final.
- Non-profits will be utilized in accordance with the needs of the festival and space availability

NO POWER & NO GENERATORS WILL BE ALLOWED

A non-profit is defined as an organization that is tax exempt as defined by the IRS and should have the necessary documentation to attach to the application.
